


Question 2


B) Effective Punishment on Crime ✓

B) Separate Courts for Gender Based Crimes


Women in Pakistan who face crimes of rape are presented in court where the judge, the lawyers and the offenders are all males. Therefore

C) Implement Phone Booths and Improve Communication Networks


Women should be assisted by implementing phone booths in public spaces ~~and~~ backed by strong communication network system to provide immediate support to victims of gender based violence and crimes.


Question 5

B) To make offenders a Good Citizens


Rehabilitation centers focus on development of personality of offenders that resonate to a functional citizen. This includes, counselling, proper timing of sleeping and emotional support.

B) Sympathy with offender and Reward on Good Behaviour


Offenders, often criticized by society for their way of doing, are provided emotional support. When offenders are rewarded for performing and showing good behaviour they get motivated.


Question 6

Scientific research is instrumental in investigation of crimes. This helps investigate to reach the criminal by scientific research such as DNA testing.


B) Investigation through Information Technology

B) Lack of innovation in Forensic Criminal Investigation


In Pakistan new method of forensic investigation lacks attention. Recently in Europe police


Question 8

B) Awareness on Television Regarding Women Safety


Government can collaborate with TV channels to present the safety guidance for women. This way women will be equipped to handle attackers.

B) ~~Artificial~~ Advanced Vehicles for Patrolling


Police department should be empowered through personalized and heli-hilly police requirement vehicles customized.
