Basic beliefs in Islam:-

Islam is a logical religion whose ideas, beliefs and practices are on human nature and can be logically tested. The basic beliefs in Islam are known as

"Imaniyat" There are five basic beliefs in Islam. Their concurrence is necessary for one to be muslim. They are given here under:

- o Belief in Allah
- o Belief in Prophethood
- o Belief in day of judgement.
- o Belief in Angels
- o Belief in Holy books

Belief in Allah:-

It is belief that there is no God but Allah. Muslims believe that there can not be multiple gods or no god. The Francis Bacon once said "It is easier to believe that there are thousand gods than to believe this universal ~~appo~~ frame is without a creator."

In Islam and in Holy Quran it has been said multiple times

"There is no god, but Allah
 and Muhammad (PBUH) is his Prophet"
 AlQuran.

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Belief in Prophet hood:-

It is faith that Allah Almighty sent his messengers, bearing his true message for humanity. It is also part of this faith that this Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) is the last prophet of Allah and there will be no more prophets after that.

“And Prophet of Allah and seal of prophet hood”

(Al Quran)

Belief in day of judgement:-

This is an necessary belief. The humans see injustice every day and don't get any punishment for it. The concept of judgement day is that one day Allah will resurrect everyone and then the great Judge will hold a court where sinners will be punished and virtuous will be rewarded.

Belief in Angels:-

It is the faith that Allah is creator on angels and that angels exist. The angels were created from light/Noor. They only follow will of Allah and can never disobey him. The famous angels are: Jibreel, Mikael, Izrael,

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Israfeel, Munkir Nakier, etc.

Belief in Holy books:-

It is a belief that Allah has sent down books on his messengers. The books such as Torah, bible are divine books but they have been altered by malicious elements of society. The Holy Quran is only book that is unaltered.

Doctrine of Al Akherat:-

The doctrine of Akherat is one of the core parts of faith in Islam. It is a logical and justifiable concept.

Need of Akherat:-

The people see, face and do a lot of good and bad deeds in world. They often get away with it or don't get necessary reward or punishment. It is logical to want a judgement day where we can see our deeds. In surah Mulk Allah told us the reason of life and death

(Al Mulk)

The Islamic faith is perfect in this regard. The muslim beliefs, practices and actions are based on morality. These are the important impacts of Islam on individual life.

1- Human dignity:-

Belief in one God and judgement day makes one more dignified. One don't bow his head on every door if he knows he will get eternal reward in the court of Allah. This also improves one's dignity and self worth.

2- Charity:-

If one knows that the worldly possessions are not eternal but reward Allah has for them is eternal they would become more charitable.

a. Salat:-

The Salat is one of the five pillars of Islam. It comes from a word which means "to pray". It is a necessary obligation that every Muslim must do five times per day.

b. Concept of Salat:-

The Salat is an obligation. The Muslims around the world first prepare themselves for Salah by doing ablution. They remove any dirt, dust and impurities from their bodies. Then they stand in unisene and face the Holy Kabaa. Then they bow their heads in front of Allah. It does not matter where one is, King or slave, rich or poor, man or woman. Everyone

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is obligatory to follow Allah,
to bow their heads.

This "odd" practice produce
a sense of unity, discipline and
brotherhood among muslims. It is
considered a way to communicate
with Allah.

Impacts on Social life:-

Salah has various impacts
on human life. These impacts are more
visible on one's social life
than any other.

1- Social cohesion:-

Emile Durkheim argued
that every society need something
to bind them. If it is lost
the society turns to crimes and
other taboos. The Islamic society
does not have this problem because
Salah binds society together
among other things. People meet
each other they interact with one
another. This cohesion reduce
crimes and improve social fabric.

2- Societal Identity:-

Salah can form societal
identity. The salah gives discipline to
society. When people meet they
form bonds with each other. They

form a common identity. This identity results in a more unified society where hearts beat with one another.

3 Discipline:-

The Salah adds discipline to one's life. You wake up early, wash one self multiple times and offer salah at various times in day. This forms a disciplined society.

Salah: Moral impacts:-

The salah has moral impacts on one's life these impacts further cause betterment of society.

1) Abstinence from sins:-

The biggest benefit one can derive from salah is that it stops one from sins. It is said in Quran.

"Indeed, Prayer prohibits immorality and wrong doings"
Al Quran.

This isn't just a statement it is the thesis of namaz. The person who offers salah stops from doing any bad deeds because they don't want to have a disruption in their prayers.

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2- Makes one Humble:-

Imagine a king, all powerful, bowing his head in the court of the king of heavens and Earths. Will this make him humble or not? The people who are offering salah are more pious and humble because they know the true Lord of heavens. They can do nothing but be selfless in the court of Allah.

The human's have always needed a spiritual sense of belonging. The human life is impacted greatly by salah.

1- Spiritual longing:-

If one associates one self with Allah they offer salah for Allah; they start to find answer for their longing. They only find comfort in Allah. They proclaim in every salah

"You alone we worship,
and to you alone we
turn for help."

Al Falaah.

This gives a meaning to human life. The person who offer salah finds great

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comfort in zikr of Allah
a Verily in the remembrance
of Allah do hearts find rest"

(Al Isra)

Right of education:-

Islam puts great emphasis on education. One does not just learn religious knowledge but worldly one too. Women and men all can learn the education without much problem.

Islam has put great effort in maintaining human dignity. This has been done through religious practices as well as judicial reforms.

1- Religious practices:-


1-Socialist state:-
