In contrast, medieval thinkers, despite their scientific limitations, possessed a unified worldview in which all forms of knowledge were interconnected. Contemporary society, though rich in information, lacks this coherence and undervalues ordinary human judgement. Restoring wholeness in thinking does not require rejecting specialized knowledge, but placing it within broader understanding of human life and values. Until, knowledge is reintegrated, society will remain rich in detail yet blind to the larger picture.
