- **Q. 4.** Discuss the main tenants and issues that shaped the foreign policy of Pakistan toward the super powers. Was Pakistan able to maintain a balance in the policy?
- **Q. 5.** An analysis of the anatomy of foreign policy is an essential pre-requisite for understanding the dynamics of International Relations. Analyze the central theme of US foreign policy in the war against terrorism? To what extent it was successful? Discuss.
- **Q. 6.** The contentious relations between Pakistan and India can be made better if the core issue of Kashmir is settled. What are the possible ways for normalizing the relationship between the two neighbors?
- **Q. 7.** Write a comprehensive note of the Great Power Policies in Asia Pacific.
- **Q. 8.** Keeping in view the developing situation in Afghanistan, discuss the role of various national and international stake holders in Afghanistan? Will there be a better Afghanistan in 2022?
