Question 5: "One day, the great European War will come out of some damned foolish thing in the Balkans". Critically analyze the statement with special focus on the events which led to World War 1.

SECTION – B

Question 6: England was victorious in World War 2, but in actual fact, it lost the war. Analyze.

Question 7: Discuss the inherent strengths of European Union (EU) which make it stand out from other regional organizations.

Question 8: Writer short notes on any TWO of the followings:

- i) Charles De Gaulle
- ii) Perestroika and Glasnost
- iii) Ukraine-Russia conflict
