- **Q. 4.** Explain the philosophy of "Judicial Review" under the American Constitution? Chalk out the similarities and differences of it under the 1973 constitution of Pakistan.
- **Q. 5.** Discuss the role of higher courts of Pakistan in the recent constructional issues and ruling of speakers of National and provincial assemblies in Pakistan.
- **Q. 6.** If U.K. has no formal written constitution, then how the UK parliament derives the powers of legislations? Why there are no constitutional restrictions on the powers of the UK Parliament whereas the powers of the Congress in the USA are checked?
- Q. 7. Can there be provisions in the Constitution just to adorn the legislation but in fact they not be actually practiced? Write a note on it referring Article 62 and 63 of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
- **Q. 8.** Discuss the constitutional provision of the Russian Constitution that make the Russian President most powerful in the country. Compare those powers with the Powers of the US president.
