- **Q. 7.** According to modern definition of security, it is the "absence of threat". Pakistan's national security now incorporates the imperative issue of 'Economic Security', encompassing climate change and food security. Explain.
- **Q. 8.** Critically evaluate the conduct, structure, strength and issues of Pakistan's Foreign Policy of 2018-2021.
