Discuss different contours of national security policy of Pakistan in light of Barry Buzan's thesis of 'conceptualization of security in 21st century'. Q4. How the concept of strategic culture can help us understand the rationales behind strategic decision making of the state? Who are the strategic elites and what makes military dominate strategic culture of the state? How to bring balance in civil-military relations in this regard?

Q5. "The real tool of imperialistic mindset is to manage global south through economic dependency." Discuss how the western world has tried to extend its influence through this neo-neo colonial tool.

Q7. Many scholars term Ukraine-Russia war as a last nail in American unipolar order. Discuss the situation on basis of concept of balance of power. Can diplomacy yield peace dividends or the muscles will prevail?
