Q No. 02 Analyze the possible impacts of Donald Trump's presidency on U.S.-Pakistan relations, focusing on key diplomatic, military, and economic changes expected during his tenure. How will his "America First" approach affect bilateral ties? Also, identify viable options for Pakistan.

Q No. 03 What are the key challenges to U.S. global supremacy in the 21st century? Discuss the role of emerging powers like China and Russia, internal political divisions, and shifting global dynamics.

Q No. 04 How have the principles of the U.S. Constitution, such as separation of powers and checks and balances, shaped American governance? Discuss its influence during critical periods like the Civil War and Progressive Era.

Q No. 05 What was the significance of the Monroe Doctrine in shaping U.S. foreign policy in the 19th and 20th centuries? How did it influence U.S. relations with European powers and interventions in Latin America?

Q No. 06 Discuss the economic, social, and political consequences of the U.S. expansion from 13 colonies to 50 states, focusing on key events such as the Louisiana Purchase and the Mexican-American War.

Q No. 07 What were the main causes of the U.S. Civil War, and what were its long-term effects on American society, particularly in terms of slavery, Reconstruction, and national unity?

Q No. 08 Discuss the causes of the Great Depression and the major reforms of Franklin D. Roosevelt's New Deal. How did these policies reshape the U.S. economy and its social structure?
